  - Preference will be given to the individuals who were involved with the Summerside Area Minor Hockey Association
  - Must demonstrate a financial need
  - Recipient should be of good moral character

**Please Note:** Below are suggested guidelines for referees to consider when preparing letters of reference for applicants. In no way are they intended to limit the points that referees may wish to address.

- Clearly explain your role and how you know the student
- Talk about the student's character; ie- what kind of person are they
- Include information about the student's potential in his/her chosen field of study
- Use examples of the student's achievements to demonstrate why they deserve this scholarship
- Address specific situations in which the student excelled
- Keep the letter no longer than one page (500 words)
