Conditions of Eligibility

- Affiliated with a Protestant Church
- Demonstrates good academic standing
- Demonstrates financial need
- Graduate of a PEI High School (or equivalent) within the last 8 years
- Enrolled in Holland College
- Resident of PEI for at least 5 years preceding application date
- Have no living parents, or have one living parent, or have two living parents, but they are unable to provide financial support for further education

** Award recipient will receive 50% of the award on or before the start date of the program, and will receive the other 50% at the midpoint of their first year of their program, provided the Registrar confirms the student has good academic standing.*
