This Scholarship Fund was established in 1991 at the close of the Canada Winter Games to honour and recognize the leadership of Orin Carver who served as Chair of the games. Mr. Carver passed in 2001.

Conditions of Eligibility:

- In graduating year of a PEI high school, or enrolled in UPEI or Holland College
- Intend to further full-time studies at UPEI or Holland College;
- Exhibit a level of excellence and leadership in either athletics or arts fields, or in community service or a combination thereof;
- Achieved an overall average of 75% during your previous academic year, with no individual subject mark less than 70%;
- Provide a transcript of your most recent academic performance endorsed by the educational institution you attend;
- Application supported by a minimum of 2 letters of reference and submit a personal statement not exceeding 500 words on how you have personally benefitted from your involvement in athletics or the arts, and your involvement in your community.

References: Below are suggested guidelines for referees to consider when preparing letters of reference for applicants. In no way are they intended to limit the points that referees may wish to address.

- Note your relationship with and knowledge of the student
- Comment on the student's character
- Share information about the student's potential in her/his chosen field of study
- Provide examples of the student's achievements
- Keep letter to a maximum of 500 words
