How can we utilize food and gardening to bring our communities together and make them more self-sufficient? How do we engage newcomers, seniors, youth and other residents in the community to work together for the betterment of their communities and PEI? And how do we encourage people to grow, harvest, and preserve their own fruits and vegetables?

We want to enhance some of the existing gardening activities and projects that are underway across the province while creating more community engagement.

Community Groups and non-profit organizations can apply for funding based on the following guidelines and criteria.

- A minimum of 20 grants of up to \$1,500 will be awarded - the number of grants and the amount funded will depend on applications and exceptions can be made for larger projects if warranted.
- Eligible applicants – not-for-profit and charitable organizations that have existing gardening related projects or those that would like to establish new projects.
- Projects will be evaluated based on the following priority areas:
  - Incrementality
  - Newcomer engagement
  - Educational components
  - Youth engagement
  - Collaboration and partnership
  - Sustainability of Project
- Projects will be evaluated using the application provided with the following:
  - Purpose (30/100) – what are they key components that will be accomplished?
  - Goals & Objectives (20/100) – what are they and are they achievable?
  - Community Impact (20/100) – what is the ultimate impact that can be made?
  - Other Partners (20/100) – is the project able to leverage additional partners e.g., resources, expertise and financial support)?
  - Intangibles (10/100) – some key elements that may not be covered within current scoring guidelines.
- Successful applicants will be expected to provide a final report with outcomes from the project. This would include both quantitative and qualitative results.
- Timing – applications will open in February 15<sup>th</sup> and will close March 15<sup>th</sup>.
- A granting committee will evaluate and score the applications and provide recommendations on the projects to be funded. The committee will make decisions by March 31<sup>st</sup> to allow for planning.
- Granting contributions will be made to organizations by end of April or before as needed by the organizations.
