The PEI Protestant Children's Trust Bursary was established by the PEI Protestant Children's Trust in recognition of its long association with the care and education of Prince Edward Island's Protestant young people. The Scholarship Fund awards are for Holland College students.

Conditions of Eligibility:

- PEI high school graduate (or equivalent), within the last eight (8) years
- First year student enrolled in a one or two-year course at Holland College
- A PEI resident for five years or more
- Affiliation with a Protestant Church (note from Church agent), regardless of denomination
- Demonstrates good academic standing
- Demonstrates financial need
- Have no living parents; OR have one living parent; OR have two living parents, but they are unable to provide financial support for further education

Successful applicants will receive one half of their bursary on or before the Start Date of the program indicated on this application. The second half of the bursary will be delivered on or after the Midpoint Date of the program. The Midpoint Date is determined at the discretion of the Selection Committee as the halfway point of the first year of a program but no later than six months after the Start Date. Successful applicants will be advised in writing of the Midpoint Date. In order to receive the second half of the bursary on or after the Midpoint Date, recipients must demonstrate that they are in good academic standing in the program in which they have enrolled.
